Summer actually becomes a busier part of our year with the traveling from our homebase in Florida to the state where we joyfully make our presentation. This year we



were pleased to team with our VP of the LCCP Board, Dave Koch, at the National LWML Convention in Omaha NE. Heavy Rains Bring Flooding at St Mark

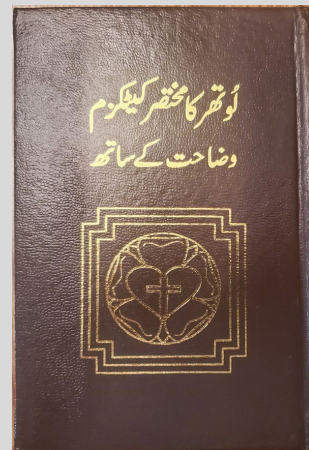
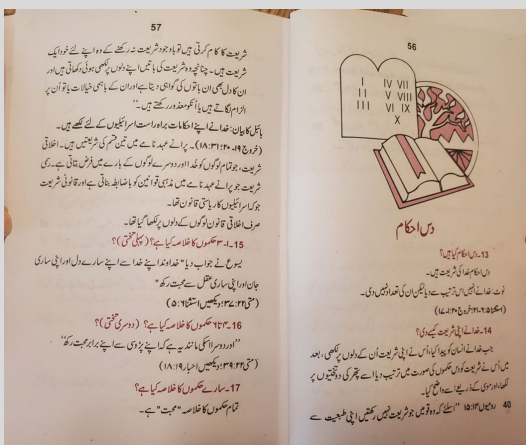
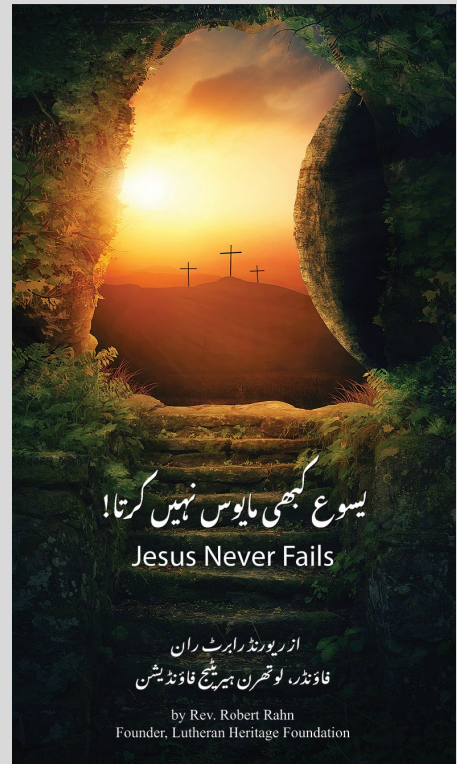

We provided the translation. They were the source of our first 100 Urdu Catechisms, which have been invaluable in many of our education programs, like confirmation and pre-seminary classes.

Getting Ready for the New School Year

After a month-long summer vacation, which is mandated by the government, we have started our school "Summer Camp" as of July 1st to teach Lutheran Music & Liturgy, English and Math. Actually, they have a better environment in the St. Mark building than at home as we have a generator and air-conditioners in the building. There are new book bags coming! We thank God and our partners-in-mission who provide this for the little lambs of God.



Pre-Seminary Training



In-depth Catechism classes are being led by Pastor Hannan to acclimate a group of men who are interested in becoming confessional Lutheran pastors. Some are more advanced than others and may have previous seminary training. Others may come from a Pentecostal background or from other Christian denominations.



Among the small percentage of Pakistanis who are Christians, there has been an inundation by chaotic Pentecostalism, upstart churches-for-profit led by self-declared 'pastors', and scammers who are angling for a connection to America. Having learned from experience, we take at least a year with each student to make sure that motivations and levels of understanding are headed in the needed direction. Please pray for God to grant that the conservative confessional Lutheran Theology of the Cross prevails.

Progress for the 'Bible-Singing Church

Reverent music as an expression of faith is at the heart of worship life in Lutheran Confessional Church Pakistan. Translating 'Mighty Fortress' into Urdu is a milestone that took almost 6 months to accomplish. Progress is being made on the ultimate goal of producing liturgy in Urdu Script, a right-to-left format.

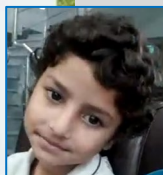
